- If you have difficulty with pick up service, questions, or special requests, call Harter's at (608) 782-2082 or toll free 866-782-2082
- If you have a billing question or vacation request, or questions about sorting, call Rushford city hall at 864-2444 or Rushford village hall 864-7974.
- Call Harter's for prices for pick up of large items such as couches, chairs, sinks, carpets, etc.
- If Harter's leaves things at curb, please call them for questions.

**All garbage MUST be in the special bags or in totes purchased through Harter's for them to collect. Special bags can be bought at Rushford Foods, Rushford Hardware, Kwik Trip or Pam's Corner Convenience. Please call Harter's if you would like to order a tote. Special bags MUST be tied shut in order for Harter's to collect. Extra garbage not in bags, untied bags, bags over 50 lbs., or bags tied to garbage cans are unacceptable and may not be collected.**

Things that will decompose and do not have a recycling market

- FOOD SCRAPS
- MILK CARTONS
- DISPOSABLE DIAPERS
- PLASTIC (Except recycle bottles and jugs)
- GLASS (Light bulbs, broken glass)
- BOTTLE CAPS & LIDS
- AUTO PARTS (Air filter, hoses, belts)
- TWINE, BANDING & STRING
- CARPET PIECES & RUGS
- BUILDING MATERIALS
- DISHES
- FURNITURE
- GARDEN TOOLS
- CARBON PAPER
- POLYSTYRENE (STYROFOAM)
- CLOTHING (soiled) & SHOES
- ALL HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES
- PLASTIC BAGS
- DRIED-OUT PAINT CANS

*Yard waste is not accepted at Fillmore Resource Recovery Center so your hauler will not pick them up. See other side for locally-sponsored pick up dates. Check with city hall for times and dates to drop off compost. City hall 864-2444.*

## ITEMS TO RECYCLE

*No need to keep separate. Can all be in one container*

### Plastics #1 - #7

*In tubs or clear bags*

- ALUMINUM CANS** - rinse
- ALUMINUM PIE PLATES, FOIL** - if clean
- COAT HANGERS**
- ELECTRIC CORDS** - old extension cords, Christmas tree lights, any copper wire
- GLASS BOTTLES** - rinse
- GLASS JARS** - rinse
- KITCHEN APPLIANCES** - small, toasters, blenders
- MISC. SCRAP METAL** - car parts, garden tools
- TIN CANS** - rinse
- PLASTIC BOTTLES** - rinse
- PLASTIC JUGS** - rinse
- PLASTIC ICE CREAM PAILS** - clean & only ones with plastic handles
- POTS AND PANS**

### FIBER Recyclables

*Bundled or bagged.*

- NEWSPAPERS** - including inserts
- ALL MAGAZINES & CATALOGS**
- CORRUGATED CARDBOARD** - flatten, cut to 2' x 2' bundle
- JUNK MAIL**
- TELEPHONE BOOKS**
- PAPER OF ALL COLORS** - examples are fax, computer, envelopes, brochures, junk mail, paper bags; may be wrinkled shredded or stapled; no paper clips
- BOXBOARD** - examples are cake, cereal, chip, cracker, tissue boxes (landfill plastic bag inserts and freezer or refrigerator boxboard containers)
